1. "If you are living a resistance free life there may be something wrong, we are born into a battle." Does this make you look at your struggles differently? How?
2. Scripture states that we are in a struggle not a battle because Jesus has already won the victory. How does this change our view on the struggles?
3. Have you ever thought about following Jesus being less like a ticket to Disney Land and more like a call to active duty? Where are you bringing about His victory across the planet?
4. "Jesus can lead us into battles so that we may know victories." Where do you feel like this has happened to you?
5. There is no victory without a battle, if you want a testimony we need a test and if we want a miracle we need impossible circumstances. What are you staring down at the moment. Take some time to share and pray for each other.
6. If David Livingstone knew peace in the midst of aggressive attackers coming for him, where do you need God's peace now?
7. How can you (together) be the answer to your own prayers at the moment? Just as Jesus said, 'You feed them.'
8. Do you feel that you are living taking captive every thought and making it obedient to Jesus?
9. What lies are you believing right now? (About motives, work, the character of God, identity, authority, ability, relationship with God, other people)
